## **The Bill of Rights is Easy to Read**

You don't need a high school education to know what they were talking about when they wrote the bill of rights. No, you only need to read it for your self again to see how plain and simple it is— but then you will surely wonder why the politicians haven't read it yet.

Here are a couple of my favorites—we don't have space for them all.

I. Congress shall make no law respecting the establishment of religion, or prohibiting the free exercise thereof; or abridging the freedom of speech, or of the press, or the right of the people peaceably to assemble,

and to petition the government for redress of grievances.

II. A well regulated militia being necessary to the security of a free State, the right of the people to keep and bear arms shall not be infringed.

IV. The right of the people to be secure in their persons, houses, papers, and effects, against unreasonable searches and seizures, shall not be violated, and no warrants shall issue, but upon probable cause, supported by oath or affirmation, and particularly describing the place to be searched and the person or things to be seized.

VIII. Excessive bail shall not be

required, nor excessive fines imposed, nor cruel and unusual punishment inflicted.

IX. The enumeration in the Constitution of certain rights, shall not be construed to deny or disparage others retained by the people.

X. The powers not delegated to the United States by the Constitution or prohibited by it to the States, are reserved to the States respectively, or to the people.

The fifth and sixth amendments will be discussed in a later issue.
